# Greenwich School

- By June 2012, the total number of students in grades 1-5 writing on or above grade level will increase by 15% as measured by the NJ Holistic Writing Rubric.
- By June 2012, 85% of K-5 students will score on or above grade level as measured by the enVisions Mathematics Benchmark Assessment.
- By June 2012, 85% of 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will advance 10 levels in math fact skills as measured by a timed Mathematics Facts Assessments.

# Stewartsville Middle School

- By June 2012, 95% of middle school students assessed using district benchmark assessments will show a 10% improvement in concepts related to probability, geometry and discrete mathematics.
- When given an explanatory, argument or narrative writing prompt in Science, 80% of middle school students will earn a 4 or greater on the NJ Holistic Writing Rubric by June 2012.
- When given an explanatory, argument or narrative writing prompt in Social Studies, 80% of middle school students will earn a 4 or greater on the NJ Holistic Writing Rubric by June 2012.
